Lots of Pain

PAYE workers, unemployed and their and children will face:

- More taxes The levies are to be doubled even for lower paid workers. The pension levy on all public sector workers remains.
- *Cutback* No mortgage relief for the majority.
- Cutback Social welfare: Christmas bonus abolished. Jobseekers allowance halved
- Cutback Rent allowance cut and early childhood supplement halved in 2009 and abolished in 2010.

No Gain

The Budget contains no proposals that would make a real difference:

- No taxes on assets of the super-rich. No increase in corporation tax.
- No measures against wealthy tax 'exiles'.
- No serious measure for job creation.
- No programme to develop a Green economy to deal with Global Warming.
- *No* reversal of the terrible cuts in health and education.



Enough is enough – It's time to take action!
