- Housing regeneration O'Devaney Gardens, Dominic Street, Croke Villas and the Dorset Street Flats must be regenerated now without waiting for private developers.
- DIT new campus at Grangegorman must include access for local people to courses and facilities
- Croke Park No parking changes for local residents and limit the number of matches and events at Croke Park.
- The Royal Canal should be developed as a linear park along its full length.

## Why should we pay for the greed of bankers and developers?

The Government wants working people, families, the vulnerable and the poor to pay for the greed of bankers, politicians and developers.

They have imposed levies on PAYE workers and cut public services. Our schools, hospitals and bus services are being savaged. They have even cut welfare payments to pensioners, families and the unemployed.

#### We say-

- Nationalise the banking system. Don't pay off the debts of the failed banks.
- A public works programme to create jobs and provide the schools, hospitals, houses and home insulation that we need.
- Free access to a top quality health service and education including pre-school education.
- Tax the speculators and super-wealthy elites who caused the economic crisis. End the tax exile status.
- **No evictions** for those in mortgage arrears. Use the 225,000 empty housing units to clear the waiting list.





## For Jobs, Services, Amenities and Real Local Democracy

Local government should prioritise providing jobs, quality services, community and youth amenities rather than looking after the interests of developers and privileged elites.

Local people should have a real say in what happens in their communities. We must stop the erosion of local democracy where power is in the hands of an un-elected City Manager.

#### We say:

**YES** to Democratic planning and real public participation.

**YES** to Regular public forums with People Before Profit councillors to involve people in local decision-making.

**YES** to A directly elected Mayor to replace the City Manager.

**YES** to Community facilities, publicly funded crèches, regeneration and social and affordable housing.



**YES** to Direct labour to provide jobs and local services.

YES to End expensive outsourcing and consultants.

**YES** to End bin and stealth taxes and privatisation of services.

**YES** to Stop the Government plans for water charges.

**YES** to Use empty homes for social housing.

**YES** to End massive subsidies to private landlords.

YES to Freeze mortgages repayments for those who have lost their
